1. Bank Draft/pay order for earnest money against each lot must reach the **Chairman Purchase Committee**, **Datum Project by registered post/ courier/ in person on or before 11:00 hours on 01-09-2025**. The bids will be opened at 11:30 hours on the same day in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives who want to come.

- 2. The method of procurement is **Single Stage one Envelope** as per PPRA's Rules.
- 3. Forms/ Proforma for Technical & Financial Proposal of each Lot, to be uploaded, is attached as **Annex-A**, **B**, **C** & **D**
- 4. Material grade should be as per sample.
- 5. Bidder shall not submit any document after due date except in response to any clarification sought by Project Director and in response to clarifications no change shall be made.
- 6. Survey of Pakistan reserves the right to reject any or all bids subject to the relevant provisions of PPRA Rules-33.
- 7. The Evaluation will be carried out lot-wise. **Individual bidder can participate in either one lot or more lots.**
- 8. Quantity of items can be increased or decreased as required by the procuring agency. The firm will be responsible to provide best quality materials.
- 9. Only registered suppliers who are on Active Tax Payers List (ATL) of FBR are eligible to supply goods. The supplier should attach a proof that he is on ATL of FBR Data Base.
- 10. In the financial Proposal of the lot, the prices should be inclusive of all leviable taxes. The bidders should also provide the detail price analysis of the items in their Financial Proposal along with net quoted unit rate with GST and without GST showing complete pen picture of their quoted prices. Prices should be mentioned both in words & figures. In case of difference, the amount given in words will be accepted.
- 11. Bids will be valid for 120 days from the date of opening of bid.
- 12. The material/items under the Lot-1 & Lot-2 are required to be supplied in parts at different locations across the country as demanded by SoP. Estimated locations are mentioned in the tender document. Supply period is expected upto February, 2026, and extendable as per ground position.
- 13. SoP will issue work order for supply of construction material as and when required. The supplier will be bound to supply the material within 7 days on receipt of work order/ telephonic demand from SoP.

- 28. The above-mentioned tools are intended for high-precision construction works; therefore, they must be of the highest quality. Samples of these tools are available for inspection at the SoP Headquarters. Bidders are advised to visit the SoP HQ Faizabad to examine the samples. Any supplied tools which deviates from the approved samples or quality standards will be rejected. The firm will be responsible to provide tools as per samples.
- 29. Bidder will provide rates as per proforma for financial proposal of each lot attached as Annexures.
- 30. Successful bidder(s) will be required to execute agreement against each lot separately governing the terms & conditions of the contract.
- 31. **Liquidation Damages:** The firm has to pay liquidation damages for the period of delays in supply of deliverables up-to rate of 2% of the contract price per month or part of a month exceeding the original delivery period subject to the provision that total liquidation damages thus levied will not exceed 10% of the total contract price.
- 32. **Performance Guarantee:** The successful bidder shall provide to Survey of Pakistan (SoP), a Performance Guarantee issued by Bank, having a value of 10% of the contract price with in 10 days of issuance of letter of intent/signing of contract and which is valid for 12 months beyond the expected date of delivery of the items/tools. Performance guarantee will remain held with SoP and will be released within 60 days of supply of goods after obtaining NOC from Technical Committee and Purchase Committee.
  - a. Bank Guarantee furnished against this contract is un-conditional and en-cashable at the will of the firm. Firm will undertake not to hinder/restrain its encashment through court, extra judicial or any other way (including administrative process)
  - b. If the firm fails to produce the Bank Guarantee within specified period, SoP reserves the right of cancelling the contract at the risk and expense of the firm. In the event of un-satisfactory performance or of any breach of terms of the contract, the bank guarantee shall be forfeited to the govt at the discretion of the firm.
- 33. **Confidentiality:** The firm shall not, during the process of execution or after expiration of this contract, disclose any proprietary or data without the prior written consent of SoP.

- 34. **Force Majeure:** Both the parties shall not be held responsible for any delay occurring in the Project due to event of Force Majeure such as acts of God, War, Civil commotion, Strike, Lockouts, Law and Order Situations, Act of Foreign Govt and its agencies and disturbance directly affecting the parties over the events or circumstances where both the parties have no control. In such an event both parties will inform each other within 15 days of the happening and within the same timeframe about the discontinuation of such circumstances / happening in writing. The firm should bid through its registered account of EPAD, which infer that the proposal submitted by the bidder is a binding of the firm.
- 35. Any firm, which furnishes wrong information, will be liable for legal proceeding. Any contract awarded in such case when find out, will be cancelled.
- 36. The bidder/lead should not be blacklisted by any of its clients. A Certificate to this affect must be submitted by the bidder.
- 37. **Litigation:** In case any dispute, only court of law at Islamabad/ Rawalpindi have jurisdiction to decide the matter.

- 1. **Technical & Financial Evaluation:** Technical & Financial Evaluation Reports of the Proposal will be made as per tender specifications.
  - a. The Procurement Committee will evaluate the Firm's proposal and qualification for each lot separately. Evaluation Criteria as below:
    - i. Certificate Active Taxpayer for-Income Tax & Sales Tax
    - ii. Compliance of each sub-item of Tender Specifications as mentioned in Form-A, B, C & D will be required as application of concern Lot.
  - iii. Certificate that "The company is not Blacklisted" on Judicial Paper.
  - iv. Pay order/bank draft as Earnest Money
  - v. Additionally for lot-3 only, submission of one sample of each of Oil Filter, Air Filter and Fuel Filter

d. The cost indicated in the Proposal shall be deemed as final and reflecting the total cost of these materials. Omissions, if any, in costing any item shall not entitle the firm to be compensated and the liability to fulfill its obligations within the total quoted price shall be that of the Vendor.

#### RESPONSIBILITY AGAINST DAMAGES/OWNERSHIP

The bidder shall be responsible for whole/any damage caused to the item(s) by accident / improper handling / loading, un-loading, before handing over to / taking charge by Survey of Pakistan (SoP). The bidder shall replace the same at its own cost.

#### **PAYMENT:**

- i. Payment shall not be made in advance.
- ii. The bidder shall provide necessary and supporting documents along with invoice.
- iii. The bidder shall submit an application for payment to the Project Director Datum Project Survey of Pakistan Rawalpindi. The application shall be accompanied by such invoices, receipt or other documentary evidences as SoP require, state the amount claimed and particulars of items supplied/equipment up to the date of application for payment.
- iv. The SoP will undergo verification of the specifications and details of the delivered items. 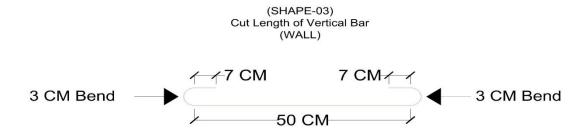

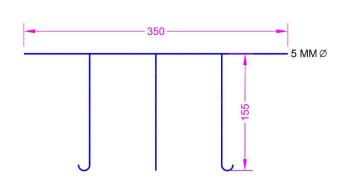


i) Profile View of the Embedded Part for Observation Room Fixing

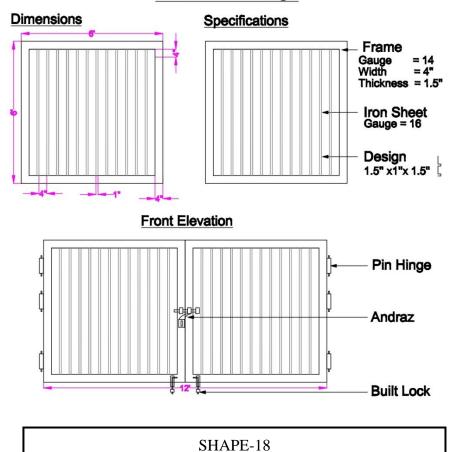
